*April 8 & 15 practice * League Apr. 22-Aug. 13 *

New pat trap thrower to start off the year excellent! Captain's meeting April 15.

Fees same as last year, CSA members \$10.00 and nonmembers \$12 each night. Teams are 5 regular and up to 3 substitutes. If you don't have a team come on out to a practice night to find a team looking for your skills or handi-cap. Any shooter under the age of 14 must have a hunter safety certificate.

New to trap? You shoot 25 at 16 & 25 for team yardage. Start times vary. 6:30pm first. 9pm last. Rotates weekly in succession. Shells cost \$7-\$10 at CSA or bring your own. Most use 7.5 or 8 shot shells.

Interested in sponsoring a team for \$40.00 per team? There will be a special free "Sponsors Night Out" scheduled with a 50 bird shoot.
